



2018 Year of the Dog Chinese Lunar New Year Poster Contest

- ✧ Theme: To celebrate the Year of the Dog with the community!
- ✧ Age group: The age cutoff date is on 12/1/17. Participants are differentiated into several age groups: Youngster (7 years old or below), Beginner (8 to 10 years old), Intermediate (11 to 13 years old), and Advanced (14 years or older).
- ✧ Registration: Please go to school website to apply [online](#) by 12/3/17. Regulations regarding the contest can be obtained through the Student Affairs Bulletin or through the South Coast Chinese Cultural Association website at www.sccca.us.
- ✧ Award: Top three winners and honorable mentions will receive certificates and trophies for their talent and effort.
- ✧ Poster Size: White or colored 22 inches by 28 inches construction paper, with 1.5 inch border for each side, shall be used in the contest. If the poster size does not comply with the rules, the work will be disqualified. The South Coast Chinese Cultural Association reserves the right to modify selected works for display. Any questions or concerns can be directed to Monica Wang in the Student Activity department.
- ✧ Rules: No three-dimensional objects or clippings may be used in the design of the poster. Please use both Chinese and English for New Year's greetings and slogans. Paint and/or color should be incorporated into the poster; colorless works will be disqualified.
- ✧ Evaluation Criteria: Equal weight will be given to following categories:
 - (1) Composition and Color
 - (2) Slogans and Contents
 - (3) Creative Design
 - (4) Overall Effect
- ✧ Due Date: The Student Affairs department will accept works until 12/3/17. Please bring in your art works in person to Monica Wang in office on Sundays before 12/3/17.



- ✧ Contest Results: Winners will be announced on Dec. 10th, 2017. Their works might be selected and displayed on campus, in addition to entering in a chance to have the work printed on the cover page of the 2018 Chinese New Year Celebration program book.
